



Support the HALT Solitary Confinement Act, A. 3080 / S. 4784

The Humane Alternatives to Long-Term (HALT) Solitary Confinement Act provides the following key mechanisms to challenge isolated confinement:

- Creates Alternatives to Isolated Confinement, including Residential Rehabilitation Units (RRUs)
- Ends Long Term Isolated Confinement
- Restricts Criteria for Placement in Isolated Confinement or RRUs:
- Bans Special Populations from Isolated Confinement

HALT Solitary Confinement Act also provides the following *key procedural and other protections*:

- Enhances Due Process Protections Before Placement In Isolated Confinement or RRUs
- Creates Mechanisms for Return from RRUs to General Population
- Covers all categories of people who currently face isolated confinement
- Mandates training, reporting, and outside oversight
